QUEEN OF THE VALLEY MEDICAL CENTER FOUNDATION was established in 1969 by Napa Valley residents who knew that a financially healthy hospital was vital to the future of their growing community. Their goal was to ensure continuing, locally directed support for quality medical care in our community.

From the beginning, the Foundation has had one mission: to help provide resources that allow the Queen to offer the best possible healthcare options for the communities that depend on it.

Since its inception, the Foundation has raised more than \$50 million for Queen of the Valley Medical Center's equipment and facilities, including minimally invasive surgery technology, while increasing community awareness of the Medical Center's needs. Its most recent capital campaign, Partners for a Healthy Napa Valley, raised \$16 million of that \$50 million.

Continual Involvement

Through its major fundraising events, sponsored activities and ongoing campaigns, Queen of the Valley Medical Center Foundation supports:

- Acquisition of new and replacement medical equipment including the da Vinci Robotic Surgery System
- Building and remodeling of the hospital campus
- Care for the poor in the community

As our community continues to grow and new medical technologies evolve, the Foundation and our dedicated volunteers will redouble our efforts to help the Queen meet our community's basic healthcare needs and offer the latest and most effective services, facilities and equipment.
